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# Introduction

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The Economic Modernisation Vision (EMV) serves as a cornerstone of the modernisation initiatives led by His Majesty King Abdullah II bin Al-Hussein. It represents Jordan's ambitious national framework for unleashing economic potential across key sectors through partnerships with the private sector. In his Speech from the Throne at the opening of the 20th Parliament's second ordinary session, His Majesty reaffirmed the critical need to advance the EMV's implementation, fostering sustained growth, launching major projects, attracting investments, generating employment opportunities, and elevating standards of living.

Jordan is steadily progressing along its path for reform and modernisation. In response to its Letter of Designation, the Government reiterated its dedication to executing the EMV, a blueprint crafted through an inclusive, participatory process involving broad national engagement and serving as the primary roadmap for its economic agenda. The Second Executive Programme (2026–2029) further advances EMV priorities helping drive economic growth and improve the quality of life.

Building on the accomplishments of the First Executive Programme (2023–2025), which encompassed essential enablers and projects that established a solid foundation, the Second Executive Programme is backed by well-defined targets and performance indicators for the coming four years.

This second phase represents a renewed commitment to initiatives and strives to facilitate seamless transitions between successive programs. Ultimately, it positions Jordan towards a more efficient, competitive economy on both the regional and global stages.



# Executive Summary

## 01 | Methodology

In line with efforts to build broad national consensus on the different priorities and initiatives within the vision sectors, the methodology adopted for developing the Second Executive Programme (2026–2029) emphasized expanding the engagement of participants in the development process.

The development process comprised several stages, beginning with the organization of (17) sectoral workshops at the Royal Hashemite Court. These workshops involved approximately (400) participants, including experts, specialists, as well as representatives from the private sector, civil society institutions, academics and media professionals. The workshops were designed to put forward practical recommendations for the Government to include in the design of the Second Executive Program (2026-2029). These recommendations were published in the sector books related to the second phase of the EMV.

Furthermore, and to help measure performance and results, vision goals, targets and KPI's were identified in collaboration with implementing line ministries and public sector institutions. This was followed by a prioritization of key economic projects, the identification of investment opportunities including mega projects and PPPs, and the inclusion of ongoing projects that continued from the First Executive Program, with timelines and performance indicators identified for all projects. This took place through a participatory process that included eighteen (18) sector based working sessions held at the Prime Ministry, with the participation of approximately six hundred fifty (650) experts and specialists from both the public and private sectors. Initiatives and projects were selected based on their economic impact on their contribution to improving the quality of basic services, in alignment with initiatives outlined in the sector books related to the second phase of the EMV.



The Executive Program is a flexible, living document that is designed to evolve with developments. It will undergo annual reviews and updates, allowing for the inclusion of new initiatives and projects that align with the Gender Budget Laws for upcoming years (2027–2029).

## 02 | Program Components

### Drives and Sectors

The Second Executive Programme (2026–2029) was designed around the same drivers and sectors outlined in the Economic Modernisation Vision document. This includes **(8) drivers and (25) sectors**: High Value Industries (including manufacturing, mining, agriculture and food security), Future Services (including healthcare, transport and mobility, logistics, markets, financial services, creative industries, trade, ICT and cybersecurity services), Destination Jordan (including tourism), Smart Jordan (including education, higher education, TVET, labor and employment, and data), Sustainable Resources (including energy and water), Invest Jordan (including foreign investment and public private partnerships), Green Jordan (including green economy and green urban development), and Vibrant Jordan (including urban development, quality of life, women empowerment and social protection).

### Projects and Initiatives

The Second Executive Program (2026–2029) projects were identified in cooperation with the relevant line ministries and public sector institutions, based on clear prioritization criteria, including potential impact, level of project readiness, alongside with budget availability. The new program comprises of **(394) projects** under **(183) sector initiatives** within the main EMV drivers. The initiatives are aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and include projects related to female empowerment and increasing women's economic participation. The Program also promotes the inclusion of persons with disabilities in education, employment and social protection. In addition, it also covers initiatives supporting the transition towards a green economy as well as plans to improve Jordan's ranking in international indicators.

### Project Cards

Detailed project cards have been prepared for each project, including specific deliverables and implementation timelines, along with defined impact indicators. All information and data on projects have been entered into the specialized dashboard at the Prime Minister Delivery Unit (PMDU).



## Measuring Impact

A strategic linkages model has been created including over **300 indicators** at both the project and entity levels with targets set for the years (2026-2029). Among these indicators, **(126) key indicators** have been identified at the driver and sector level within the second Executive Program document. These indicators were strategically mapped with the goals and objectives in a comprehensive strategic framework.

## 03 | Indicative Budget

The indicative budget of the Program for 2026-2028 is estimated at **JD 3.8 billion**. This aligns with Law No. (16) of 2025 / the General Budget Law for the fiscal year 2026. Sources of funding include the general budget and foreign assistance. Indicative costs will be reviewed based on priorities and progress annually and in line with future budget preparations.

## 04 | Alignment with SGS and Persons with Disabilities

The Program is aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to and helps accelerating progress towards 2030 goals. It includes initiatives directly and indirectly related to the empowerment of women and increasing their economic participation, as well as initiatives that support and include persons with disabilities.

## 05 | Monitoring and Tracking Progress

To ensure effective implementation, the Prime Minister Delivery Unit (PMDU) will maintain its role in the periodic tracking of progress within the Program in coordination with all Performance Monitoring Units (PMU) in relevant line ministries and institutions.

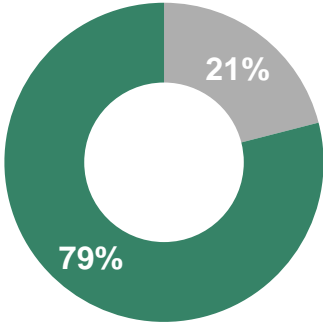

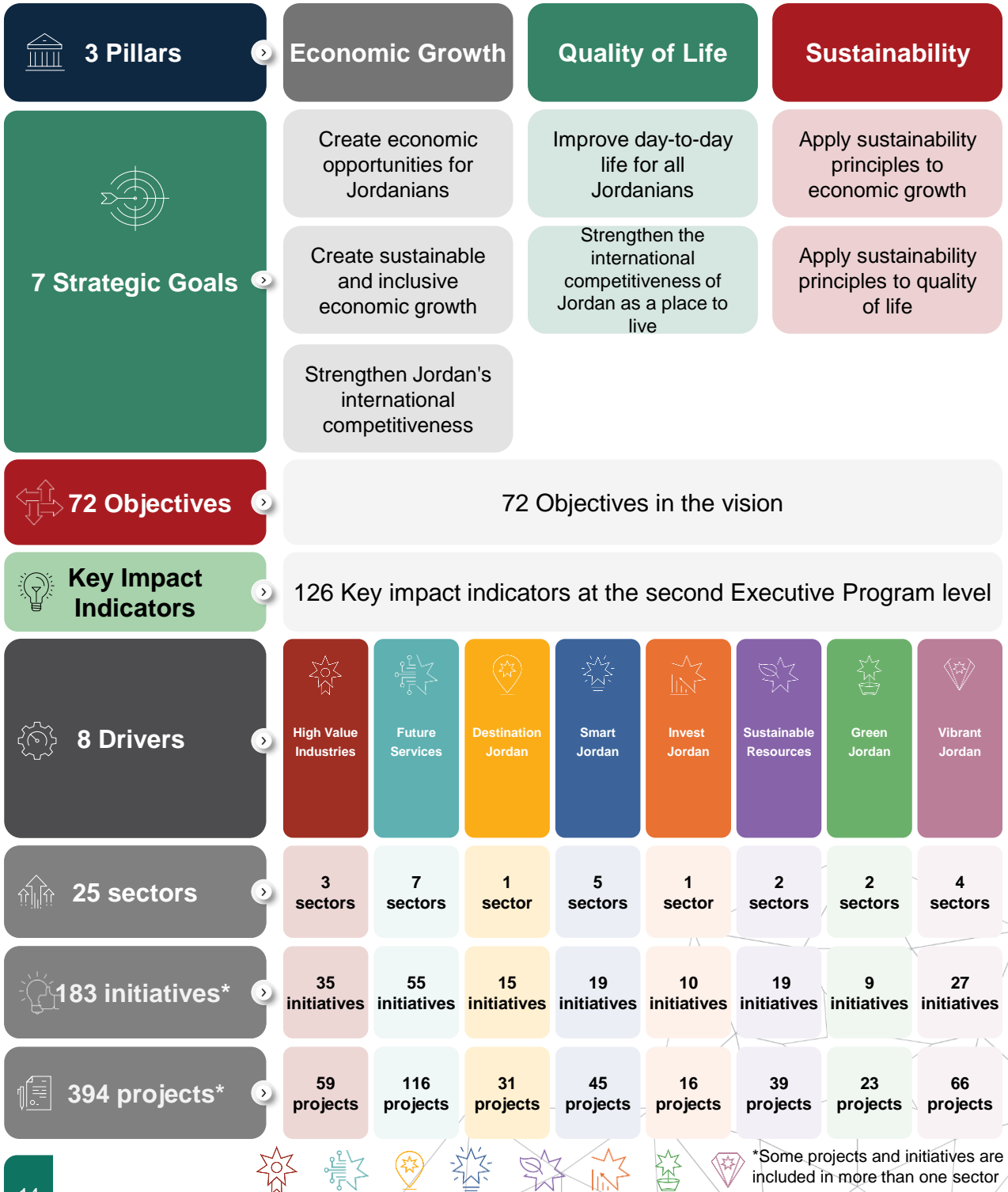


**Women's Empowerment**

## Strategic Linkages Model and Key Impact Indicators

A strategic linkages model and key impact indicators serve as an integrated methodology to ensure the alignment of the Vision's projects and initiatives with the pillars, goals, and objectives within the Second Executive Program. The map is based on 3 pillars, 7 strategic goals, and 72 objectives, with results measured through 126 key impact indicators identified at the driver and sector level. These indicators were strategically mapped with the goals and objectives in a comprehensive strategic framework. The goals are achieved through 8 drivers, including 183 initiatives and 394 projects, making it an essential tool to support decision-making, strengthen governance, and ensure the realization of national impact targets.

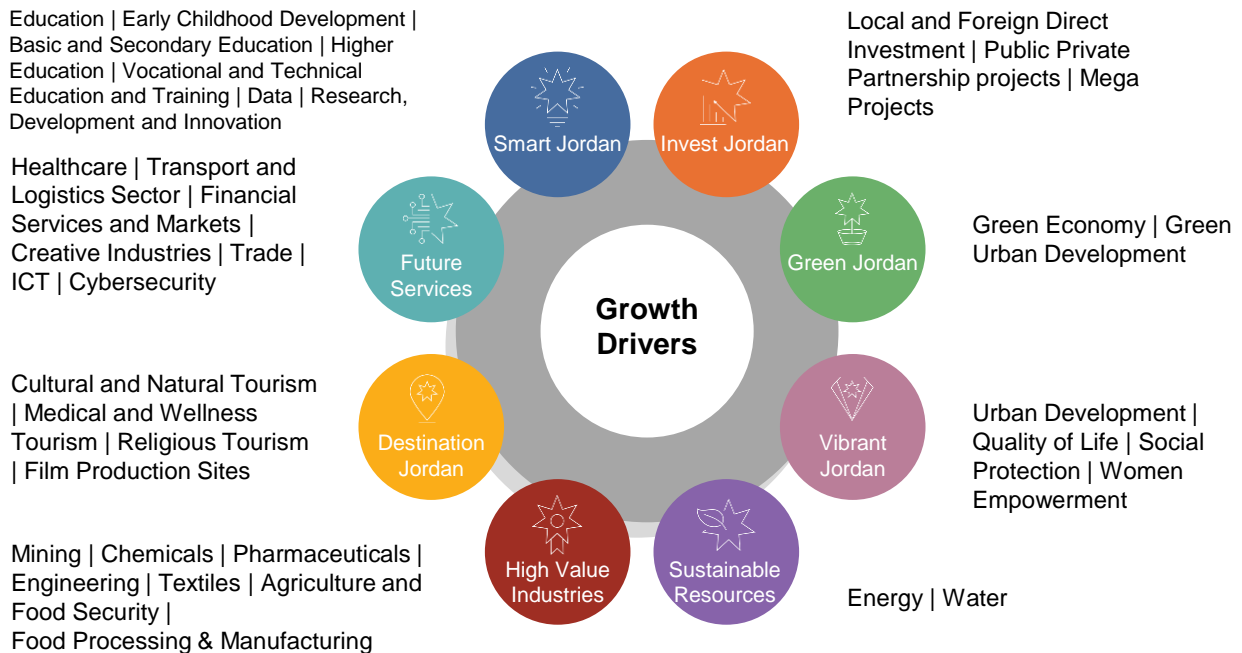


# Drivers of the Economic Modernisation Vision

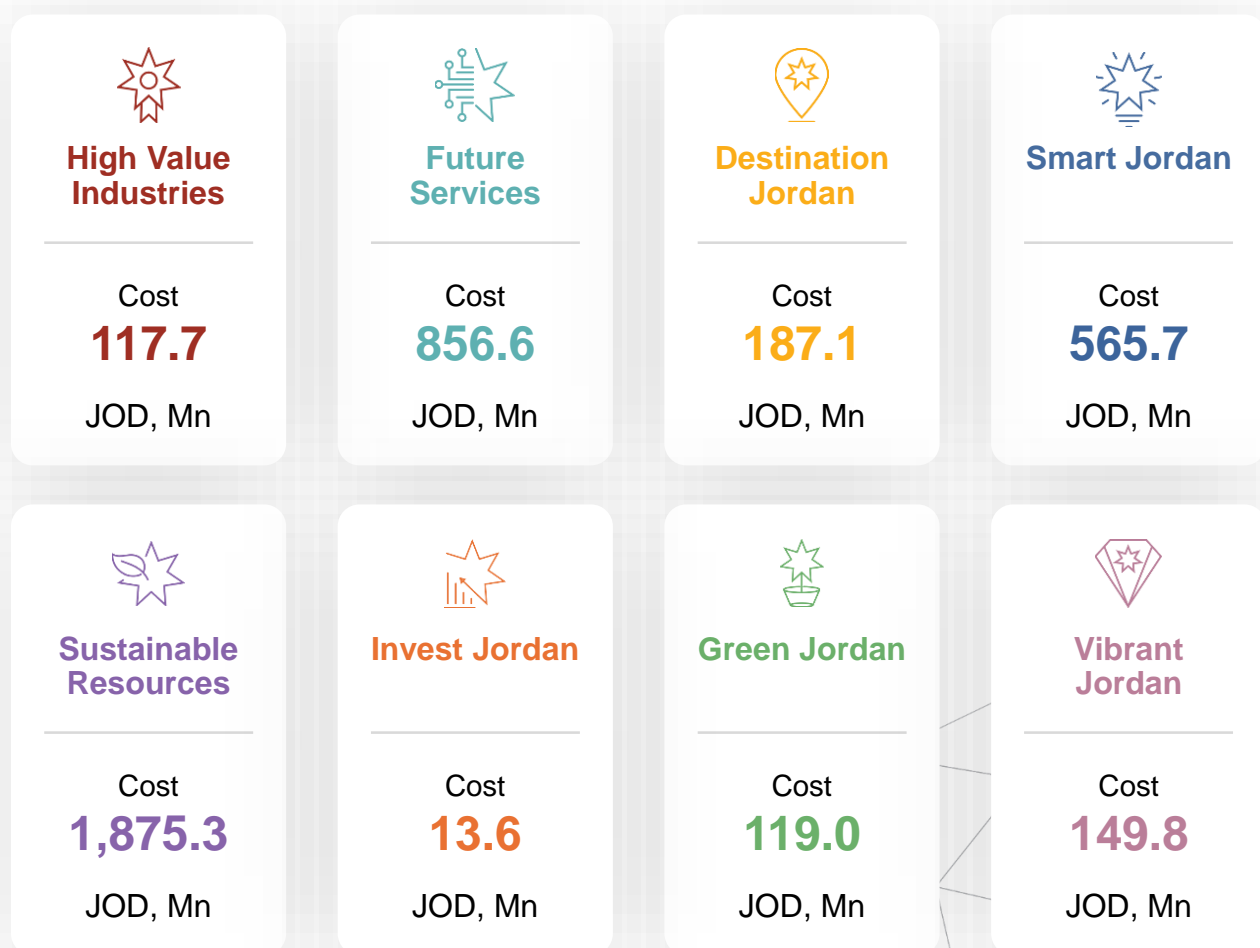

## Mechanism for Monitoring Progress of the Executive Program

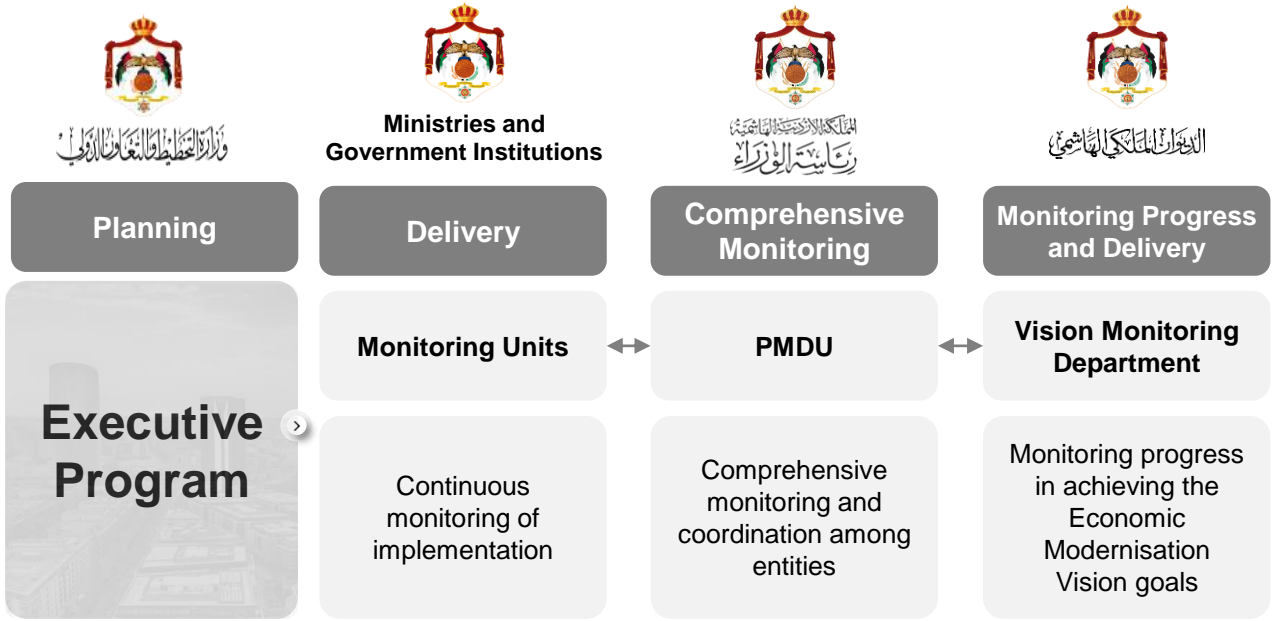
In order to ensure the effective implementation of the projects under the second Executive Program of the Economic Modernisation Vision (2026-2029), the Prime Minister Delivery Unit plays a pivotal role by developing an integrated ecosystem of tools and systematic mechanisms to measure performance, monitor progress, and support the implementation of projects. The ecosystem includes an interactive electronic system for tracking progress, supported by periodic reporting, and detailed project cards. Each card outlines clear outputs, implementation timelines, performance indicators, and specific impact indicators to measure the actual impact of these projects.

As part of the efforts exerted to institutionalize delivery monitoring and support activities across government entities, the Prime Minister Monitoring and Delivery Units play a significant role in connecting the ministries and government institutions with the Prime Ministry Delivery Unit. These units are responsible for monitoring project delivery, compiling periodic reports, and identifying any challenges related to the delivery of these projects. This contributes to boosting the efficiency of institutional performance and ensuring alignment with the monitoring ecosystem adopted for the implementation of the Executive Program.

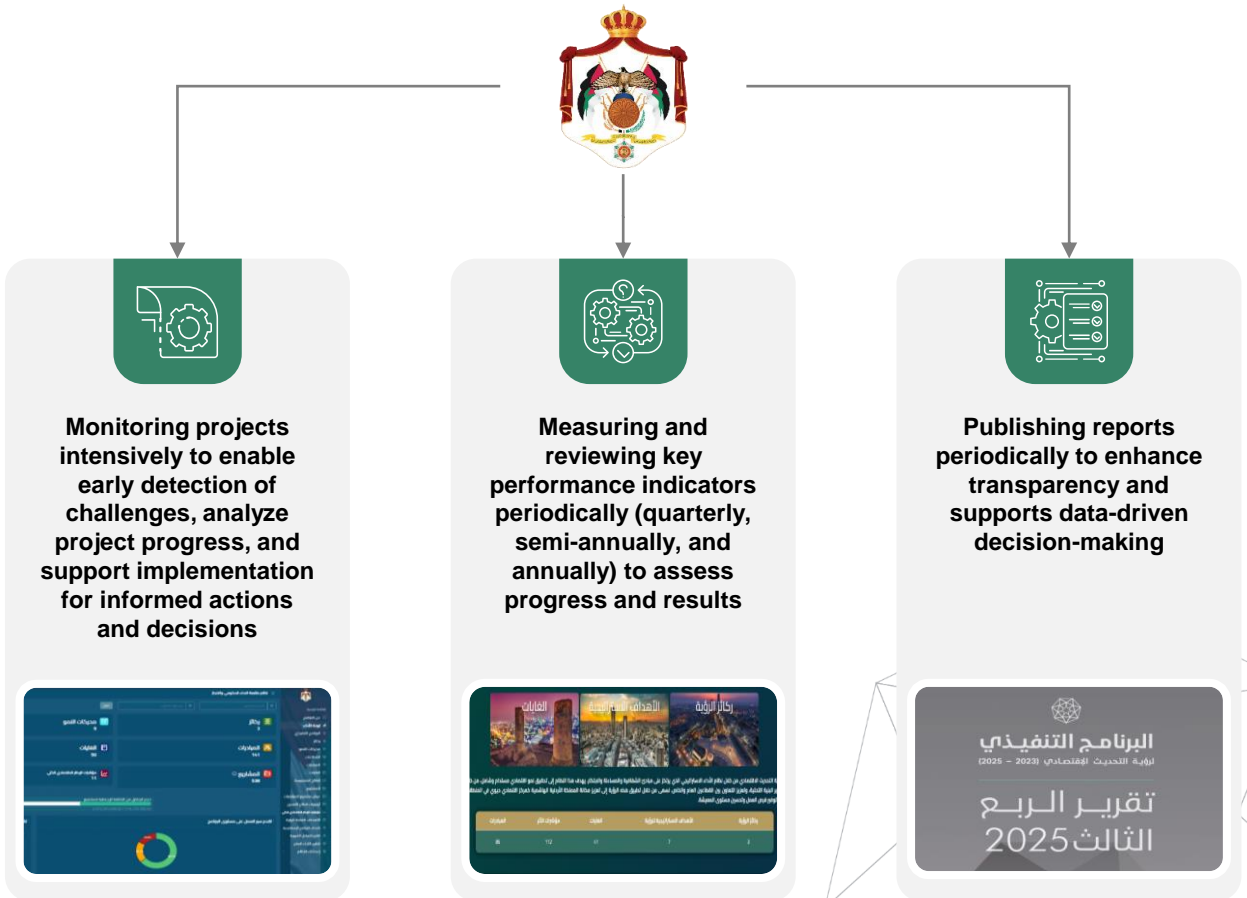
